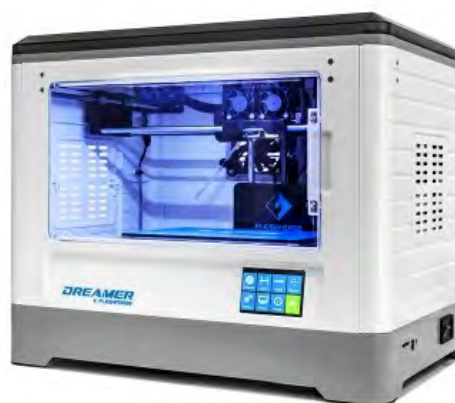

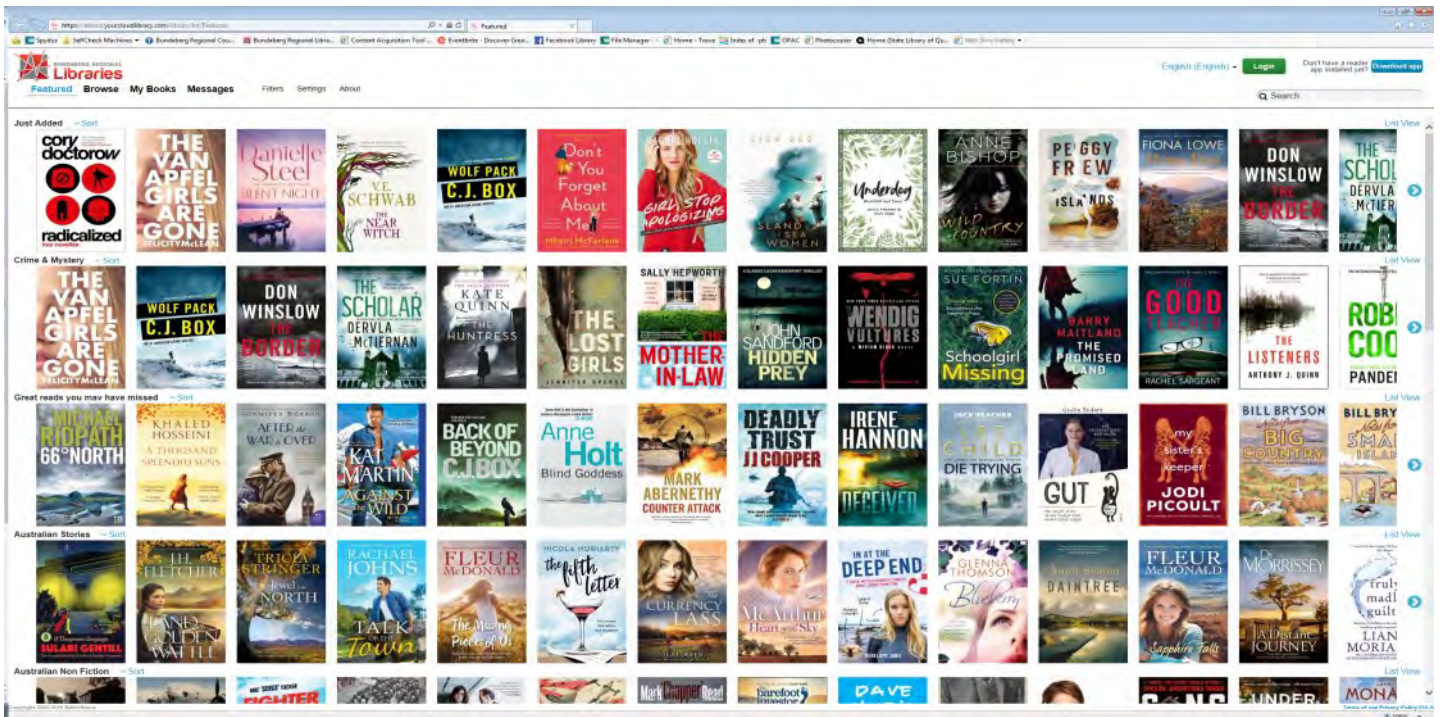

cloudLibrary - ebooks



All you need is your library card and pin to gain access to over 4000 titles from cloudLibrary at Bundaberg Regional Libraries. Simply download the app on your device, log in with your library membership and start reading. One-click category selection allows you to customise which genres you like to see. There is advanced filtering that allows you to sort by author, publication date, title, rating, etc. You can also save titles for future reading. Please ask staff if you need any assistance.



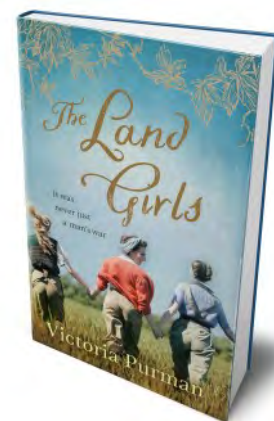

Holy Rosary Church, Barolin Street, Bundaberg, ca. 1960. (John Elworthy collection, bun06701). On the 10th October 1886 His Lordship Rt. Rev. Dunne, the Bishop of Brisbane laid the foundation stone of the new Catholic Church in Bundaberg. The building was designed by F.D.G. Stanley. The Church was constructed in brick by E. Boyle, a Bundaberg contractor and was completed and consecrated in 1888. Reconstructed in 1926, the transept and sanctuary map out a cross shape. The first church in Bundaberg was built on this site at the corner of Barolin and Woongarra Streets in 1875.
